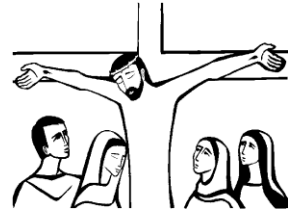

Sisters of St. Elisabeth Convent in Minsk, Belarus, is a Christian community that supports a large psychiatric hospital; takes care of an orphanage for children with mental and physical disabilities and runs a rehabilitation center and a shelter for the homeless will. Many people who come to the convent for help (former hospital patients, the homeless, the needy) become involved and together with the sisters produce beautiful religious handcrafts and souvenirs made with love and prayer. Wood and metal works, stone and ceramic workshops, iconography and recording studios, a publishing house, a tailor shop, a bakery, a farm, willow-weaving, felting, mosaics workshops and many more - altogether creating hundreds of jobs and, more importantly, introducing people to Christianity through joint humble prayer.

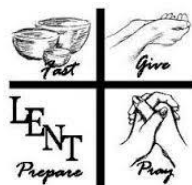
